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THE PROGRAM

The Top Aces Aviation Experience was developed to immerse students into the fascinating world of aviation. It puts them inside real aircraft, shows them the magic of flight through incredible cinematography and provides the unforgettable experience of flying high performance flight simulators.

The program includes the four 1 hour activities listed below:

"At The Controls" Flight Simulation

Students experience flight at the controls of F/A-18 Hornet flight simulators including 20 minutes of pre-flight training and a 20-minute simulator flight. Training and the flight are focused on either aircraft landings or air-air combat as chosen at the time of booking.

Guided Hangar Tour of the Museum's Historic Aircraft

Your students will be guided through a one hour tour of the museums

beautifully restored aircraft, many of which still fly today. Students experience the aircraft up close as their tour guide use the aircraft to engage them in a presentation about aspects of aviation such as Canada's rich military aviation history or the general principles that make flight possible.



"The Magic of Flight" Documentary Movie

"The Magic of Flight" is a 40-minute documentary on flight from its beginnings with the Wright Brothers through to the Blue Angels featuring spectacular aviation video footage followed by an opportunity for teachers to tie the movie's content into their classroom work.



Mayday! Mayday! Mayday! SAREX Team Survival Exercise

Survival is the name of this activity. The students aircraft has crashed and participants need to use critical thinking to survive in this teambuilding exercise based on real world pilot survival training. The survival exercise is approximately 30 minutes and is run in conjunction with a mid- day lunch break.

COST, PLANNING AND BOOKING INFORMATION

Target Audience

Ideal for grades 6 and above for groups from 8 to 32 participants.

Cost

Cost per student is \$24 and includes there 40 minute simulator training and flight.

Payment

Payment is expected upon arrival. We accept payment by Visa, Mastercard, Interac, cash or



cheque payable to Canadian Warplane Heritage Museum. A \$20.00 administration fee will be added if payment is not made upon arrival and invoicing is required.

No payment is required for supervisors up to a maximum ratio of 1:8 (supervisors to students). In addition to at least one teacher a minimum of two supervisors is required. Additional adults will need to purchase their own admission at the general admission rate. A support person accompanying a student with a disability will be admitted free.

The program is HST exempt. Programs, prices and policies are subject to change without notice. No additional coupons, promotions, passes or membership discounts apply.

Supervision

Supervisors are required to remain with their students and be responsible for discipline at all times. Please ensure that your students and supervisors are aware that the following conduct in not acceptable:

- conduct which is harmful to the exhibits and displays or disruptive to other visitors
